Indicated below are primary items that 11th and 12th grade students are having troubles with in their reading.

- 1. Know how to think as you read.
- 2. Know how to overcome boredom.
- 3. Know how to adjust to an author's style.
- 4. Know how to avoid frustration.

The answer key below is for the reading check. The numbers to the right represent the 4 areas of student problem areas. Example: if a student missed #1 it might suggest that knowing how to think and overcoming boredom is a problem. After all 31 questions are answered and a composite is made a plan can be made for the student to overcome their area (s) of difficulty.
